

Boaters: Cuesta Inlet is private property!



Boaters have been able to enjoy Cuesta Inlet because of the generosity of the property owners. Use of the property is with the permission of the owners as an accommodation to the community and is subject to the owners' control. There has been an increasing amount of litter, derelict boats and trailers, dog poop and other ugly stuff left on this land. To preserve your ability to recreate and launch you must immediately:

- License your boat
- Permanently place contact information on your boat, kayak or canoe in a highly visible location
- Secure your boat so it cannot float away during high tides or be damaged during high winds
- Secure all lines and halyards from clanging
- Trailers may NOT TO BE STORED at Cuesta Inlet
- Boats, not regularly in use must be removed from this property and MAY NOT BE STORED at Cuesta Inlet
- Do not leave your boat in the pathways
- Remove water from your boat so it will not become breeding grounds for mosquitoes
- Pick up after your dog
